



# GRADUATE WITH A MONASH ARTS VERTICAL DOUBLE DEGREE IN FOUR YEARS

## In an exciting new initiative you can now complete a Bachelor of Arts plus a masters degree in four years!

The advantages are:

- Refine your skills and knowledge in a field you're really interested in
- Make yourself more employable with two degrees
- Save time (from 6–12 months) and reduce fee debt

### HOW IT WORKS

After completing two years of your Bachelor of Arts course you will take masters level units as your electives at third year. You then complete the remainder of the masters course in fourth year.

Your masters degree will be related to your major. So if you were doing an international relations major in your Bachelor of Arts you could complete masters units in international relations as your electives in third year. In fourth year you would complete the Master of International Relations and graduate with both a Bachelors and related masters degree.

### ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

**BA entry students:** ATAR of 90+ and a 75% average at completion of 96 points from the BA.

**Existing BA students:** A 75% average at the completion of 96 credit points of studies from their BA and required pre-requisites units to progress into level 4 or 5 year units.
